You are expected to perform safety and safeguarding checks before every session.

By not doing so, in the eyes of the law, you are operating negligently.

Safety, first

Your safety check before every session:

- Unstable goals
- Damaged nets
- Spillages in and around the playing area
- Hazards and sharps in and around the playing area
- Equipment / objects in and around the playing area
- Well-stocked First Aid kit

What to do:

1. Keep kids off the pitch / out of the hall
2. Explain the delay to parents
3. Remove the hazard
4. Adjust the session accordingly (usually, this means dropping the skills part of the session)
5. Report it on the Google Drive
